Amid readying herself for a few late week photo shoots, actress and model Annamarie Lytle chatted with SOAK from her sick bed, as she battled a bout of laryngitis—what a trooper—to tell the world about “Sex and Lies,” what it was like to work on the set with Tori Spelling post-90210 days, and what it’s like to have three brothers while being a half-naked sister in a magazine. **SOAK:** *What have you been up to lately?*

Annamarie: I am currently the new face for the Milani cosmetic campaign, so I have been busy promoting the line. Just last week I had a small role in an independent film called “The

Iron Man” which is a comedy. I love comedy so I had a ball being on that set. Physical comedy is my specialty! My idol growing up was Lucille Ball.

**SOAK:** *Where are you from and what has been your path to being on magazine covers and in movies?*

Annamarie: I am a California girl all the way. I was born in Long Beach. I have lived in Los Angeles the last four years. My path to become an actress and model started when I was very young. I started performing at the age of four. I was a jazz dancer all the way through high school and competed on dance teams. I always wanted to be an actress so

halfway through college, I decided to move to LA and give it a shot. An artist’s life is a tough path, but I never want to be 80 years old one day and look back and say I could of, or should have. It’s now or never for me! I did fall into modeling though. I am not tall; however, I met my modeling agent at a party for the wrap of “Baywatch” and have been with him ever since.

**SOAK:** *Is it weird having guys ogle you when you’re on magazine covers or when you’re in sexy spreads?*

Annamarie: Well, I don’t really get to see their reactions, so no. I find it very flattering if they like my spreads. I have never really thought of myself as a sexy girl but if they do great!

**Annamarie:** I produced, directed, and acted in a show last summer at the Hudson Theatre in LA. It was called "Sex and Lies." There were four scenes, each completely different. I played a heroin addict in one and a messy roommate in another sort of like "The Odd Couple."

**SOAK:** *What's your favorite kind of music?*

**Annamarie:** I love music and all different types. I recently saw Coldplay and U2 in concert—best concert that I have ever seen. I like the Deftones and a CD called "Hotel Coste" as well.
